



## REGISTRATION IS NOW OPEN FOR THE FUTURE OF STEAM EDUCATION CONGRESS

**Gothenburg, Sweden – October 28, 2024** – Registration is now open for the **Future of STEAM Education Congress**, scheduled to take place from **February 3rd to 5th, 2025** in Gothenburg, Sweden. This event will convene visionary educators, industry leaders, educational policy experts, cutting-edge researchers, and passionate students from across Europe to explore the latest trends in STEAM education, share best practices, and forge collaborations that will shape the future of STEAM education in Europe.

The congress will emphasize promoting diversity and inclusion in STEAM fields, with a special focus on enhancing female participation and supporting underrepresented groups. Attendees will contribute to significant discussions and initiatives aimed at transforming STEAM education to be more inclusive and impactful.

Over the course of three days, participants will experience a variety of sessions designed to inspire and educate. Plenary talks will feature insights from STEAMbrace on the latest STEAM trainings, while keynote speeches from prominent members of the STEAM Alliance for Europe will provide valuable perspectives. General discussion panels will refine co-created activities for the upcoming STEAM Week, and focus group or roundtable discussions will address adapting STEAM activities to diverse needs. Additionally, workshops will showcase innovative STEAM approaches in both formal and non-formal education, and poster sessions will highlight sister projects and initiatives related to STEAM education. Networking opportunities during coffee breaks will foster collaborations among attendees.

Institutions, organizations, individuals, and experts are encouraged to share their knowledge and expertise with the audience. Interested participants are invited to fill out the registration form to be contacted with further details.

Participation is invited in various capacities, including as keynote speakers, focus group facilitators or participants, workshop leaders, and poster presenters. Collaboration on untested ideas is also welcomed, with co-design workshops available to refine and develop these into effective activities or workshops.
